

A NOTE ON POPULATION SIZE AND SAMPLING

Using last year's admissions numbers as a benchmark, the population for this study was approximated at 2,250 students. The research was designed to operate under a level of 95% confidence and within a limits of accuracy of 5%. With a predicted non-response rate of 40%, it was concluded that a sample of 451 students would be selected to contribute. The participants were chosen by means of simple random sampling.
